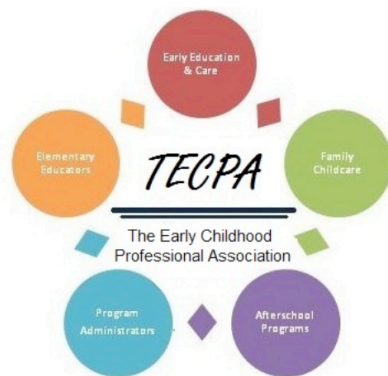


# *Join us for our next TECPA Natick Program*
